Subject: Board of Representatives Committee Notes

* The financial report was reviewed and accepted as presented, only timing of revenue and expenses were recognized as minor issues and will catch up in future YTD numbers.

*Supervisor Christy Board of Supervisors, Pima County reported Green Valley potentially being researched for a dog park with mixed response. Fire wise continues to be of active interest in the Green Valley Community as a result of increased home owner insurance rates.

* Chief Wunder Chief of Santa Rita Fire District, over 100 calls primarily related to slip and falls, noted most are in showers and bathrooms with need for properly installed hand rails and avoiding wet floors. October is fire prevention month in Arizona a stark reminder especially in forest fires and drought conditions.

* Lieutenant Bernstein Pima County SO, the deaths on I-19 have created a joint effort of AZ Highway patrol, Sahuarita and Pima County to do additional posting on the four lane to attempt to regain control of speed on I-19.

* Tom Murphy Mayor Sahuarita, the cinema is getting closer to opening, Popeyes reopens, workforce development program working with high schools for summer and filling local employment needs. Pecan property discussing potential future land sales which could involve the town of Sahuarita. Very important issue as water usage will be greatly reduced from agriculture use versus residential.

* GVC President Kenyon report, mobile health van plans consistent first of the month stops in Green Valley at 9:30 am at Joyner public library. This service is for anyone needing elementary care and testing with a fully capable van with equipment and staff funded by Pima County. Please do not flush old drug prescriptions into the public sewer system, it is detrimental to the processing units and to avoid future issues with ground water. One of the Pima County Forums is addressing and presenting an end of life planning session for those who want to know the appropriate process to better understand the confusion over the number of forms and filing of who what and where.
