Leaving for the summer? Or for an extended trip?

- Give a neighbor a key to your home so they can check inside for a water leak or other emergency, and to reset timers after a power outage.

Home burglaries are no longer uncommon in Green Valley....

PREVENTION STARTS WITH TAKING PRECAUTIONS

1 – Be sure your home appears occupied. An occupied appearance will discourage burglars.

Put lights on timers;

different timers in different rooms, going on and off at different times.

Approximate your activity flow, like the bedroom going dark last.

Put a radio on a timer.

2 – Ask a neighbor to occasionally park in your driveway.

3 – Arrange for your maintenance service to regularly trim bushes, and clean up your yard.

A “cared for” look to your property is probably the most important preventative measure you can take.

4 – Consider installing an electronic alarm system.
